Some may remember that, each Sunday morning, I text our ARVBA pastors to encourage them as they prepare to bring God's Word to the people. Last Sunday's note was typical:

"Pastors: The first Sunday in March - For some, this month marks the end of the church's first quarter. - For others, it is the halfway point of the church year. - Either way, for you, it is the first chance this month to share the Word with the people who have been placed in your care. - The Lord could do something extraordinary thru the sermon you preach on this first Sunday. - He really could! - Preach well my friend. - You always do!"

The first Sunday in March. It was not until I sat down to write that note that I realized our 2023-2024 Association year will be half over at the end of this month. Half over already! It is true what they say, "The older you get, the faster time seems to move".

I reached a milestone last month. On February 20th I joined the ranks of the Medicare insured. Where has the time gone?!
