It was quiet in my Mission Trip mini-mansion when I first started this article. It wasn't really a mansion in the truest sense of the word, but is actually a mud room where guests hang their waders after duck hunting. The lodge manager let me sweep out the dirt from years gone by and move in with the spiders and dirt dabbers. It may not sound like the best of sleeping quarters but, knowing how loudly some of my fellow missionaries snore, I was happy to make the sacrifice.

It was been a hot and fruitful summer for ARVBA Missions and I have been hard pressed to keep up.

As usual, it began with the annual Church Camp. 365 campers made the trip to Spring Lake this year and saddled up for a week of western-themed preaching and bible study. 33 students gave their hearts to Jesus and another 10 recommitted to His Lordship over their lives. Other significant decisions included 9 campers indicating they sensed a call to the ministry! Your all-volunteer Church Camp sets a high standard every year and Camp 2025 was no exception. Every part of Camp was well-planned and prayed over. Our Worship Teams, Camp pastors, Recreation/activities Directors, Cabin Supervisors, etc. all went the extra mile to make sure your church kids enjoyed the best camp experience ever. Delta Missions 2025 kicked off just one month after Church Camp. Forty-nine ARVBA'ers traveled to Southeast Arkansas on July 13th for a week of intensive missions work. The Team helped Revive Church in McGehee, and Eudora Baptist Church, Eudora conduct the most impactful Vacation Bible School events either church had had in years. Attendance was awesome, both VBS teams were awesome, the Carnivals were awesome (We even added pony-rides this year courtesy of the Church In The Dirt folks!), and the number of kids who gave their hearts to Jesus was beyond awesome! All told, at least 20 souls were added to God's Kingdom as a result of the efforts of ARVBA Delta Missions Team and others!

It was hot, generators conked out, fire ants attacked, storms popped up, tires went flat and even blew out! We ran out of ice, we ran out of prizes, and we ran out of water on more than one ocassion. But our folks hung in there, people showed up, and God showed out! Plus, we ate really well, and stayed in a lodge! It was a Godhonoring labor of love and communities were changed forever.

The work we do at home and around the state leads to unexpected opportunities to serve the Lord in other places. Earlier this year, our State Convention inquired as to the possibility of our Association providing a block party for a struggling, but passionate, church near Mena, Arkansas. Much like we did at Cornerstone Baptist Church near Gentry Arkansas, we will bring the Rec trailers to Concord Baptist Church in Mena and set up an awesome ARVBA Carnival. The church folks won't have to worry about set-up/teardown, workers, or supplies. They will be free to 'shake hands and kiss babies' while making contacts for follow-up and gospel conversations.
